NATIONAL DROPOUT PREVENTION FUND

Statement of Purposes

The general purpose for which the National Dropout Prevention Fund is organized is to provide a locus of operation for addressing the national issue of school dropout. In particular, the Fund hopes to bring that issue before the American people and to expose its dimensions, hopefully to stimulate national attention toward eliminating the problem.

Specifically, the Directors of the Fund have identified the following activities as essential to the above stated purpose of the Fund:

- (1) To provide a vehicle for combatting the dropout problem by promoting public awareness.
- (2) To support, develop and implement programs to encourage students to complete their high school education.
- (3) To encourage citizen and community group involvement in the efforts to prevent students for dropping out of school.
- (4) To direct resources of the private sector toward a solution of this national tragedy.

The Fund intends to run fundraising solicitations in national magazines, which will be offering such advertising space to the Fund on a pro bono basis. Because that fundraising campaign will be nationwide, the Fund has endeavored to register as a charitable organization in all of the fifty states, even though at the time of this registration there may not be identified any specific program to be carried out in a given state. It is anticipated, however, that several of the programs to be carried out by the Fund will be of such a nature as to have an effect, whether direct or indirect, on every state, such as a national symposium to be held by the Fund which will invite participants from across the United States.


