Attachment to Articles of Incorporation (non-profit) of
Vision Bible College
Dated 3/1/2000

Article 2: Vision Bible College shall be organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. It's charitable purpose shall be exclusively for religious purposes, including the organization and holding of Religious Services, Teaching of Bible College Courses, conducting Evangelistic Outreaches and Missions Trips, and all other activities necessary for the Training of Christian Ministers. Also including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal Tax Code.
