ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
of
THE FIRST PROTESTANT CHURCH OF PIERCE, IDAHO

EMMETT C. BONNER, President, and HELEN KINARD, Secretary,
of the above named corporation respectfully show that:

The above named corporation was organized under the
laws of the State of Idaho on September 12, 1973.

The above named corporation, upon the proposal of its
board of deacons, set forth the proposed amendments and
directed that said amendments be submitted to a vote of the
shareholders entitled to vote in respect thereof at a
designated meeting of such shareholders, and upon the adop-
tion thereof by the shareholders at said meeting as provided
by law and as hereinafter more specifically set forth, does
now hereby, through Emmett C. Bonner, President, and Helen
Kinard, Secretary, execute and acknowledge the following
articles of amendment of its articles of incorporation:

1. RESOLVED That the first sentence of Article II,
which reads as follows:

"That the corporation is created for the accom-
plishment of religious, social and benevolent
purposes and shall have for the accomplishment of
such purposes the following powers and authority,
to-wit:"

be amended by striking the same and substituting
in its place the following:

"That the corporation is created exclusively for
the accomplishment of religious, charitable and
educational purposes and shall have for the
accomplishment of such purposes the following
particular powers and authority, but not to exceed
the powers permitted to an organization which is
exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
Revenue Code, to wit:"

2. FURTHER RESOLVED That a dissolution clause be added as an Article X, which reads as follows:

"Sixth: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."

At a regular shareholders meeting on May 25, 1975, at 2 p.m., at the First Protestant Church of Pierce, Idaho, in Pierce, Idaho, upon the call and notice required under Idaho Code Section 30-1103, a majority of a quorum attending said meeting adopted the above two amendments by an affirmative vote.


