RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, the undersigned incorporator being of the age of eighteen years or more, desiring to organize a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby make, sign and verify these Restated Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is ***TRUCKMASTER LOGISTICS SYSTEMS, INC.***

ARTICLE II

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- (a) To undertake any business activities of any kind or nature for which businesses may be lawfully incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho;
- (b) To do all other things necessary or incidental to the foregoing business purposes.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares, in a total amount of 10,000 shares. The stock shall bear no par value. Shares of stock of this corporation shall not be transferred or sold until said sale shall be approved by the Board of Directors of this corporation, in accordance with the duly adopted By-Laws of this corporation.

IDAHO SECRETARY OF STATE

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The capital stock of this corporation, after the amount of the subscription price or par value has been paid in, shall not be subject to assessment and no paid up stock and no stock issued as fully paid shall be assessed or be assessable.

ARTICLE V

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is *980-B West Main Street, Jerome, Idaho, 83338*.

The name of the initial registered agent at such address is *DOUG BLEVINS*.

ARTICLE VI

The name and address of the person who shall serve as director of the corporation until the first annual meeting of shareholders is:

ARTICLE VII

The name and address of the incorporator is:

DOUG BLEVINS - 980-B West Main St., Jerome, Idaho 83338

ARTICLE VIII

No private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall be subject to or liable for payment of corporation debts.

ARTICLE IX

By-Laws shall be adopted by the Board of Directors, and when so adopted, may thereafter be repealed, amended or new By-Laws adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Directors.

ARTICLE X

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter provided by law, and all rights conferred upon stockholders of this corporation are granted subject to this reservation.

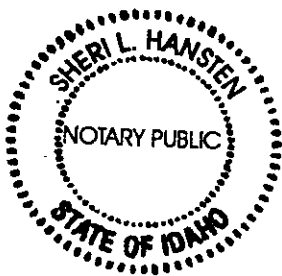

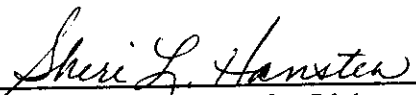

**CERTIFICATE ACCOMPANYING
RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

COMES NOW, Doug Blevins, Sole Shareholder and Director of Truckmaster Logistics, Inc., an Idaho Corporation, and certifies to the Secretary of State of the state of Idaho that:

1. This statement does contain an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation which required shareholder approval.
2. The name of the corporation prior to adoption of the amendment was Truckmaster Logistics, Inc. Its name is now Truckmaster Logistics Systems, Inc.
3. The text of the amendment adopted to the Articles of Incorporation is as follows:
Article I is amended to read as follows:

The name of the corporation shall be Truckmaster Logistics Systems, Inc.

4. The amendment was adopted at a meeting of the Director of the corporation and a subsequent meeting of the shareholder of the corporation on the 15th day of May, 2001.
5. At the shareholder meeting held the 15th day of May, 2001, 1000 shares were issued and outstanding and entitled to vote on the amendment. At the meeting of shareholders, 1000 votes were cast in favor of the amendment, and 0 votes cast against it.
