In the matter of the incorporation of the Village of Hollister:

It appearing that the minutes of the proceedings of the Board at the regular January Session and on March 9, 1917, relative to the incorporation of the Village of Hollister, do not fully set out all the proceedings had and taken on said day nor all the findings and conclusions of the Board in connection with the incorporation of the said Village of Hollister, it was ordered that the minutes of the proceedings of the Board on the said 9th day of March, 1917, insofar as they related to the matter of the incorporation of the Village of Hollister, be amended, and they were amended to read as follows:

"In the matter of the incorporation of the Village of Hollister."

In this matter a petition was filed with the Clerk of the Board praying for the

incorporation of the Village of Hollister, purporting to be signed by a majority of the taxable inhabitants of said Village, setting forth the name they desired to assume and designating the metes and bounds of the proposed Village. The Board, having made a careful investigation in the matter and being fully advised in the premises, found as follows:

- 1. That said petition is signed by a majority of the taxable inhabitants of said proposed Village of Mollister.
- 2. That inhabitants to the number of two hundred or more are actual residents of the territory described in said petition.
- 3. That said petition designated the name which said inhabitants and petitioners wished to assume as the Village of Hollister.
- 4. That said petition describes the boundaries of said Village and designates the metes and bounds thereof, which description is identical with the metes and bounds thereof designated in the following order. The following order was then entered;

The village of Hollister is hereby declared and ordered incorporated, the said Village to be known as the "Village of Hollister" with boundaries designated and described by metes and bounds as follows:

Commencing at a point 25 ft east and 25 ft north of the Southwest corner of section 28, Tp 12 R 16 E.B.M. thence North approximately one and three quarters (1 3/4) miles to a point 25 ft east of the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW, NW, NW, of Section 21, Tp 12 S. R. 16 E.B.M. thence east along the south line of the north half of said section 21 approximately one (1) mile to a point 25 ft west of the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter (NE, NR; of said section 21, thence south approximately one and three quarters (1 3/4) miles to a point 25 ft north and 25 ft west of the southeast corner of section 28, Tp 12 R 16 E.B.M. thence west approximately one (1) mile to the point of beginning.

The following citizens of the Village of Hollister all and each of whom, having the qualifications provided in said Section Ho 2224 of the Revised Codes of Idaho, are hereby appointed to act as Trustees of the Village of Hollister and hold office and perform all the duties required of them by law until the election and qualification of their successors at the time and in the manner provided in Title 13 of the Political Code of the Revised Codes of Idaho:

There being no further business to come before the Board recess was taken until 10 A.M. July 3rd, 1917.

In the matter of the petition of S.T. Hamilton requesting the cancellation of Del Tax Certs Nos.2195 sale 1916; 2104 sale 1917; 2193 sale 1916; 2103 sale 1917:

The Board after carefully considering said petition and having determined from the records, that the lands covered by said certificates were as yet Government lands, and not subject to taxation, the Board therefore ordered that Certificates 2195 sale of 1916; 2104 sale 1917,; 2193 sale 1916; and 2103 sale of 1917 be canceled for reason that said lands were erroneously assessed.

In the matter of the petition of L.E. Smith requesting cancellation of Tax Sale Cert. 2003 and 2048 1914 taxes:

In this matter after careful investigation, the Board determined that as yet no proof had been made on lands covered by said certificates, they therefore ordered the cang cellation of Tax tale Certificates Nos 2003 and 2048, taxes for the year 1914, for the reason that said lands were erroneously assessed.

In the matter of the petition of G.W. Plummer requesting cancellation of Tax Sale Certificate No 699 Taxes of 1916:

In this matter it appearing from the affidavit and otherwise verified that the property covered in said certificate is owned by the Trustees of the Oregon Conference of Evangelical Association and that said property has been in use for church purposes for the last two years, the Board deeming themselves fully advised in the matter ordered that tax certificate No 699 taxes for the year 1916, be cancelled.

In the matter of the approval of depository bond of the Bank of Rogerson:

In this matter Bond having been filed with the Clerk, with the Bank of Rogerson as principal and Fidelity and Guaranty Co as surety, in the penal sum of \$5,000.00, the Board after examining said bond ordered same approved, and named the Bank of Rogerson as

Minutes of Special Joint Meeting, Board of County Commissioners and Buhl Highway District, Buhl, Idaho, Wednesday March 7th, 1917. All members were present.

On motion of Mr Ostrom, Mr O. H. Carlson was elected Chairman of meeting. Suggestion was offered by Mr W.H. Harvey that Mr Fox explain to meeting his survey of Lilly trail-Salmon River grade. Mr Fox explained fully and a general discussion of the matter was indulged in. Mr Fox was requested to state the cost of grade on each side of Salmon River, he reported the cost on south side would be \$5,574.90 and on north side \$13,904.70 total #19,476.60.

Motion was made by W.H. Harvey, second by Mr Moore that County Commissioners
Buhl Highway Dist, and town of Jarbidge each appoint one man, making a committee of three,
with instructions to go over the various routes between the U.S.L. Hy and Jarbidge for the
purpose of making a reconnoissance, after which a report should be made to joint meeting
of County and Buhl Highway Dist. Commissioners, recommending the most feasible and practicable route. Motion carried.

It was the sense of meeting that the general public should be invited to this coming meeting so that all interested parties or communities could have an opportunity to present arguments for or against any particular route to Jarbidge.

It was agreed that this Committee would not be appointed until communication could be had with Jarbidge on the subject and a date set for the trip.

The Commissioners now went into executive session when a further discussion of the whole Jarbidge road matter was had. Loved by Mr Carlson seconded by Mr Molander that Mr A.E. Fox be engaged to make survey of present Castleford crossing grade to determine beyond question the merits of this crossing in comparison with the recent survey on the Lilly trail. Motion carried. Moved by Carlson second by Childs that County and Buhl High-second divide equally the expense of survey of Castleford crossing. Motion carried. County of Twin Fella being no further business to come before the Board, meeting adjourned.

Regular January Session 10 A.M. March 9th 1917.

The Board met at this time pursuant to recess. Present O.E. Carlson, Chairman T.E. Moore, D.P. Albee and E.J. Finch, Clerk.

Whereupon the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of the incorporation of the village of Hollister:

In this matter a petition praying for the incorporation of the village of Hollister having been filed with the Clerk, said petition having been signed by what is purported to be a majority of the citizens within the limits described as the boundaries of the proposed village of Hollister. The Board after careful investigation, and having determined to their satisfaction that the number of signers of the said petition represented the majority of tax paying inhabitants within the proposed village, exceeded 200, being fully advised and deeming such action for the public good ordered the incorporation of the rillage.
