One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-nine and duly recorded on Film No. 109 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at St. Maries, in the County of Beneval.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

CITY CLUB OF ST. MARIES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WE, the undersigned, of full age, at least twothirds of whom are citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify in writing.

I.

The name of said corporation shall be CITY CLUB OF ST. MARIES, INC.

II.

The purposes for which said corporation if formed are to engage in the on-sale dispensing of alcoholic beverages and food, operating as a bar and restaurant, and generally to purchase or otherwise acquire restaurants and taverns, and to own, hold, lease, rent or sell such business or businesses, and to engage in all businesses and do all acts permitted by law. Additional to the foregoing, to have all of the powers of corporation provided by the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly all of the rights and powers set forth in Idaho Code 30-114, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto.

III.

The registered office and place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is at St. Maries, Benewah

The duration of this corporation and the term of its existence is perpetual.

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The number of directors of said corporation shall be three. The number of directors may be increased by the shareholders at any regular meeting, or at any special meeting of which notice of such purpose of given. A director shall hold office for the term of which he was named or elected, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

VI.

The total authorized capital stock of the corporation is 1,000 shares of the par value of \$10.00 per share, making a total authorized capitalization of \$10,000.00. Each share entitles its holder to one vote without preference. The stock shall be common stock and shall be non-assessable.

VII.

The power to repeal and amend the by-laws and adopted by-laws is hereby conferred upon the board of directors.
