Now, therefore, the said named and undersigned parties do hereby certifyand dellare and agree, as hereinafter set forth, and do hereby, for the purposes aforesaid and hereinafter mentioned, associate themselves together and enter into the following agreement, under the laws of the State of Idaho, to wit:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

FIRST: The name of this corporation is and shall be, THE WRIGHT MURCANTILE COMPANY (LIMITED).

SECOND: This corporation shall continue in existence for a period of twenty-five years, unless somer dissolved and disincorporated according to the law.

THIRD: The business and pursuits of said corporation shall be to buy and sell all kinds of merchandise and to buy and sell all kinds of farm products, to buy, own and hold real estate necessary for the operation of said business.

ation is to be transacted shall be Idaho Palls, County of Bingham, State of Idaho. But said corporation may purchase, obtain, hold, operate and

improve real estate and personal property incident to its business purposes in any part of said state of Idaho or any other place or places are of the necessary and requisite in carrying out the lumposes of this incorporation, or for the sale of any of its property or merchandise or farm products.

FIRTH: The amount of the capital stock of this comporation shall be Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, which shall be divided into Two Hundred Fifty (250) shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each.

SIXTH: The officers of this Corporation shall consist of a Board of Tive Directors, a President, a Vice President, a Secretary and Treasurer, whose qualifications shall be to own and hold stock in the Jurporation, and whose tora of office shall be one year, and until their successors shall be elected and qualified. The President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer shall be elected by the Board of Directors and the President and Vice President shall constitute a part of the Board of Directors and be included in the five (5) Directors constituting the same. The offices of the Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person properly qualified.

And it is hereby provided that a failure to hold said last named meeting, or any general meeting of said stock-holders of said Corporation, at the time appointed for the same, shall not forfeit or in any war interfere with the Corporation's rights acquired under this agreement, but any such meeting shall be held at any subsequent time, upon giving fifteen days notice in the manner provided by the by-laws; and notice of all meetings of the stock-holders, whether general or special, shall be given as prescribed by the by-laws.

shall neet and organize as a board, and shall elect a President, a vicePresident, a Secretary and Treasurer and such other officers and agents
as may be provided for by the by-laws. At elections by the Directors
they may vote either by ballot or viva voca, in accordance with the wish
of a majority of the members of the Board of Directors present at such
meeting at which such election is to be held. A majority of the whole
number of Directors shall form a quorum, and shall be authorized to
transact business and exercise the corporate powers of the Corporation.
