The Board finds the following by be the facto.

First: That the netes and bounds of the proposed willage are as fullows:

Seginaing at the Southeast termer of See 31, Tr 7 N.z Al d.B.M. Thence running West one mile, thence North one half mile, thence East one mile, thence South one half mile to the place of beginning, and embracing the South half of Section 31. Township 7 North, Range 51 B.B.M.

Second: That there is now residing within the said described bearitory more than two hundred bona fide residents.

Third: That a majority of the taxable inhabitants thereof, have signed the potition graying for the incorporation of said territory into a village, and that they wish to assume the mane of Teton Dity:

It is therefore ordered that the said village be and the same is hereby declared interporated under the name of Teton City, and that the said order be made of resort in the Johniesianers Journal, and the following Trustees are hereby appointed: James Siddoway, Fred Schwendinan, Thomas C. Stich, John Donaldson, and Frank Graham, each being over 21 years of age, atax payer and inhalibants of said village, for more than one year last past, and they each shall hold their office and perform the liquides thereof, until the election and qualification of their successors as prescribed by law.

Ordered that this Board do now adjourn till temorrow morning at C A.M.
