In the matter of the application by petition of W. H. Cleward, Jesse W. Baker, William Taylor and seventy one others for the incorporation of the Village of Teton City.

The Board finds the following to be the facts.

First: That the sites and bounds of the proposed village are as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Sec 31, Tp 7 N. R. 41 E. S. 4. thence running West one mile, thence North one half mile, thence East one mile, thence South one half mile to the place of beginning, and embracing the South half of Section 31. Township 7 North, Range 41 E. S. 4.

Second: That there is now residing within the said described territory more than two hundred bona fide residents.

Third: That a majority of the taxable inhabitants thereof, have signed the petition praying for the incorporation of said territory into a village, and that they wish to assume the name of Teton City:

It is therefore ordered that the said village be and the same is hereby declared incorporated under the name of Teton City, and that the said order be made of record in the Commissioners Journal, and the following Trustees are hereby appointed: James Siskoway, Fred Schwendiman, Thomas G. Smith, John Donaldson, and Frank Graham, each being over 21 years of age, atax payer and inhabitants of said village, for more than one year last past, and they each shall hold their office and perform the duties thereof, until the election and qualification of their successors as prescribed by law.

Ordered that this Board do now adjourn till tomorrow morning at 9 A.M.
