Pius, Bishop, Servant of the Servants of God, to our beloved son, Edward J. Kelly, Bishop-elect of Boise, health and apostolic benediction. The duty placed upon our humility by the eternal Prince and Pastor of ruling, caring for and governing the Universal Church places upon us the obligation of most carefully arranging that such prelates be established in all the churches who have both knowledge and ability to beneficially care for the flock of the Lord. Since the Cathedral Church of Boise, suffragan of the metropolitan Church of Oregon City is at present vacant by the death of Daniel Mary Gorman of happy memory and desiring to beneficially provide for the flock of the Lord of the same Church and having consulted our venerable Brethren, the Cardinals of the Holy Roman Church, we by our apostolic Authority elect you, Doctor of Philosophy and Theology, to the same Cathedral Church and we place you in charge of the same as Bishop and Pastor with all the duties and obligations inherent to this pastoral office. We wish however and order that all other things required by law being observed before you receive episcopal consecration that you make the profession of faith and give the eucharistic oaths to whatever Catholic Bishop you may choose provided he has the favor of and communion with the Holy See, according to the forms prescribed by the Apostolic See and that you are absolutely bound within six months to send to the Apostolic Chancery copies of the same signed and sealed by yourself and the said Bishop. To this purpose by these present letters we commit to the Bishop chosen by you the duty and the mandate of receiving in our name and that of the Roman Church the profession and those oaths. We reserve moreover to ourselves and the Apostolic See the faculty of arranging new limits to this diocese in whatever manner and time is pleasing to us and the same See. We entertain a strong hope and confidence that with the propitious assistance of the hand of the Lord you will usefully govern the aforesaid Church of Boise by your pastoral energy and fruitful care and that the same Church will increase in spirituals and temporals.

Given at Rome at St. Peter's in the year of our Lord 1827
on the 13th day of December in the sixth year of our pontificate.
