

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MACKAY BUSINESS ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned incorporators, desiring to form a non-profit corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE: The name of the Corporation is Mackay Business Association, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO: The purpose of the Corporation is to increase the economic stability of Mackay and help the city prosper by providing assistance and support to new and existing businesses.

ARTICLE THREE: The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.
