

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

SWEDISH MISSION CONGREGATION CHURCH SOCIETY.

KNOW ALL MEN, That we the undersigned have been heretofore associated together (but not incorporated) for the general purposes of a church organization under the rules and regulations of the Swedish Mission Congregation of America and for the better accomplishment of said purposes have decided to become incorporated and to that end have had an election in accordance with said rules and regulations, and thereby elected the five directors below named and have chosen ourselves, the undersigned to be the charter members of said corporation and therefore we have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, in pursuance of and for the purposes hereinafter set forth, and therewith organizing a Company and corporation the object of which is not for pecuniary profit;

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of this corporation shall be "THE SWEDISH MISSION CONGREGATION CHURCH SOCIETY".

SECOND. The purposes and object for which said corporation is formed are to acquire and hold sufficient land for church purposes and to dispose of a part thereof for a cemetery, the same to be the Southeast quarter (1/4) of the Southeast quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-eight (28) in Township 2 North of Range Thirty-seven (37) E.D.M.

To improve and beautify the same, and to hold and maintain the church and ministers residence on the same and to do any and all things necessary for the support and maintenance of religious worship according to the doctrines of the said church organization known as the Swedish Mission Congregation of America.

THIRD: The place where the principal business of said corporation shall be transacted and where its corporate office shall be is the New Sweden Precinct, Bingham County, Idaho, and the Post Office of said corporation shall be the City of Idaho Falls, in the same County.

FOURTH: The term of the existence of said corporation shall be fifty years.

FIFTH: The number of Directors of said corporation shall be five, and the names and residences of those who have been so elected to serve as Directors the first year are ;

That the said Directors were duly elected, at a meeting of the members of said unincorporated Association, duly convened at the church of said Association in the New Sweden Precinct, Idaho, on the 13th day of September 1906, for the purpose among other things of providing for said corporation and of electing Directors to take the charge and management of the property and affairs of said society and said corporation.

That a majority of said members were then and there present, and voted at said election for the above named directors, as is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification by the officers who conducted said election, hereto annexed, and made a part of these Articles.

SIXTH: This corporation has no Capital Stock.

SEVENTH: The following persons have each subscribed to these Articles, as the Charter members of the said corporation.
