

DESIGNATION OF AGENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF
THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Twin Harbors Lumber Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, having filed herewith in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho a duly authenticated copy of its Articles of Incorporation, does hereby make this certificate, and does hereby designate Clearwater County, State of Idaho, as the county in which the principal place of business of said corporation in said State of Idaho shall be located in the event said corporation does business in the State of Idaho, and does hereby designate Michael E. McNichols, residing at Orofino, in said Clearwater County, as the authorized agent of said corporation in the State of Idaho, upon whom process issued by authority of, or under any law of the State of Idaho, may be served, as provided by the constitution and laws of the State of Idaho.

Twin Harbors Lumber Company does not, by these presents, admit to having done business in the State of Idaho, and specifically denies that it has ever done business in the State of Idaho. Twin Harbors Lumber Company is a plaintiff in a civil action to foreclose a mortgage in the District Court of the Second Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Clearwater, Case #3668, and makes this designation and acceptance, and intends to qualify to do business in the State of Idaho pursuant to Section 30-506, Idaho Code, as amended, for the purpose of eliminating any question as to its status to bring said suit or to obtain the relief prayed for therein.

And the said Twin Harbors Lumber Company, desiring and intending to conform in all respects to the constitution and


