## ARTICLES OF INCOMPORATION

OF

UNION COMMISSARY, INC.

We, the undersigned, natural persons of full age, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, associate ourselves together for the purpose of organizing a non-profit co-operative association, and declare:

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The name of this corporation shall be Union Commissary, inc.

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The purpose of this corporation is to do all things necessary and proper to carry on a general merchandising business at any place in the United States of America under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, 1.C.

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Profit shall never be the object of this corporation.

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The period of existence of this corporation shall be prepetual.

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The location and post office address of its registered office im this state shall be Box 2143, Idaho Falls.

VI

Corporations and associations and co-partnerships, as well aspersons, may be members of this association, provided such

corporations, associations and co-partnerships are affiliated with a labor union, and provided the persons are members of such a union.

The rights and interests of all members of this corporation shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest in this corporation than any other member.

VIII

The affairs of this corporation shall be governed by a board of six directors, the members to be elected for staggered terms of six years each.

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This corporation shall not have capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the board of directors, and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe.

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The by-laws to be adopted by this corporation shall provide:

- 1. The number and qualification of members and the terms and conditions of admission.
- 2. The time, mode, conditions and effect of expulsion or withdrawal from, and of restoration to, membership.
- 3. For the assignment or transfer of the interest of members, the manner of determining the value, if any, of such interest, and the purchase by the corporation at its option of such interest upon the death, withdrawal, or expulsion of a member.
- 4. Fees for admissions, assessments or dues to carry on the business of the corporation, and reimbursement for services rendered, and expenses incurred, by the corporation for its members, the time of payment and manner of collecting the amounts due, and for forfeiture of the interest of a member in the corporation for non payment thereof.

5. These articles of incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the members at any regular meeting of the members of the corporation with the approval of the board of directors.
