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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the understigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho, and the Acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

FIRST

The name of the corporation is Respir Care, Inc.

SECOND

The purposes and objects for which the corporation is formed are:

- (a) Medical supplies and gas, sales and rentals;
- (b) To purchase for investment or resale, and to deal in, land and other property of any tenure and any interest therein, and to create, sell, or deal in, any freehold, leasehold, ground rents, and to make advances upon the securing of land, houses and other property and any other property, whether real or personal;
- (c) To make any improvements upon any real property, including, but not limited to, the subdivision thereof, the installation of water systems, sewer systems, the building of structures for rent or sale or lease, the general improving of sites, the building of roads, fences, and any and all other improvements deemed advisable by the Board of Directors of the corporation;
- (d) To buy, sell, acquire, hold, own, dispose of, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, assign, transfer, trade and deal in and with all kinds of personal property, franchises, privileges, rights, goods, wares and merchandise of evey kind, nature and description;
- (e) To buy, sell, convey, lease, let, mortgage, exchange or otherwise acquire and dispose of lands, lots houses, buildings and real property, hereditaments, and appurtenances of all kinds and wheresoever situated, and of any interst and rights therein, to the same extent as natural persons might or could do and without limit as to amount;
- (f) To acquire by purchase, subscription, or otherwise, and to own, hold, sell, negotiate, assign, deal in exchange, transfer,

mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and shares of capital stock, scrip, bonds, mortgages, securities, or evidences of indebtedness, issure or created by any other corportation, joint stock company or association, public or private, or by whomsoever issued, and while the holder or owner thereof to possess and exercise in respect thereof any and all rights, powers and privileges of owenership, including the right to vote thereon;

- (g) To make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and description made for any lawful prupose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association or corporation, either public or private, or with any territory or government, or any agency thereof;
- (h) To borrow money, to draw, make, accept, endorse, transfer, assign, execute and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, and other evidences of indebtness, and for the purpose of securing any of its obligations or contrancts to convey, transfer, assign, deliver, mortgage and or pledge all or any part of the property or assets, real or personal, at any time owned or held by this corporation, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors shall authorize, and as may be permitted by law;
- (i) To acquire, hold, sell, reissue or cancel any shares of its own capital stock, provided, however, that this corporation may not use any of its funds or property for the purchase of its own common stock when such use would cause any imparirment of the capital of this corporation; and provided further, that the shares of its own capital stock belonging to this corporation shall not be two ted directly or indirectly;
- (j) To purchase or otherwise acquire the whole or any part of the property, assets, business and good will of any other person, firm, corporation or association, and to conduct in any lawful manner the business so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the conduct, mangement and carring on of such business;
- (k) To organize, promote, incorporate and reorganize subsidiary corporations and joint stock companies and associations for any prupose permitted by law;
- (1) To have one or more offices to carry on all or any part of its operations and business, and to do all and everything necessary, suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein named, or which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law, and this to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do as, principals, agents, contranctors, trustee, or otherwise, and either alone or in connection with any person, firm, associations, or corporation;

(m) To have and to exercise any and all powers and privileges now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations formed under the general corporation laws of said state, or under and Act amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto or substituted therefor:

The foregoing clauses are to be construed both as objects and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that enumeration herein of specific objects and powers shall not by held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation; provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business or exercise any power or to do any act which a corporation formed under the Act hereinbefore referred to, or any amendment thereof or supplement thereto, or substiture therefor, may not at the time lawfully carry on or do. It is the intention that the purposes, objects and powers specified in each of the subparagraphs (a) to inclusive, of paragraph Second of these Articles of Incorporation shall, except as otherwise expressly provided, in no way be limited or restricted by refernce to, or inference from, the terms of any other subparagraph, clause or paragraph of these Articles of Incorporation.

THIRD

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

FOURTH

The name and location of the registered agent and office of the corporation is:

FIFTH

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be and is 1,000 shares of stock of the par value of \$1.00 each, making an eggerate stock of \$1,000.00 which stock shall not be issued until fully paid for and once so issued shall be nonassessable.

SIXTH

The names and post office addresses of the incorporators and the number of shares subscribed for by each, are as follows:

Sandra L. Vega 770 S. 12th E., Mtn. Home, ID 83647 - 100 shares

SEVENTH

The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any

extent whatever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business, or paying debts of the corpostation.

EIGHT

The number of directors of the corporation shall be specified in the by laws and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as may be prescribed in the by laws, and in accordance with Section 30-1-36 of the Idaho Code provided that the first Board of Directors shall be one in number. No decrease in the number of directors shall have the effect of shortening the term of any incumbent director. In case of any increase in the number of directors, the additional directors may be elected by a majority of the remaining directors though less than the quorum of the Board of Directors. The directors so elected shall hold office until the next annual meeting or at any special meeting duly called for that purpose and until their successors are elected and qualified.

NINTH

The names and addresses of the members of the first Board of Directors of the Corporation are: Sandra L. Vega, 770 S. 12th E., Mtn. Home, ID 83647.

Such persons shall hold office until the first annual meeting of shareholders, and until the successors have been elected and qualified.

TENTH

Stockholders of the corporation shall have pre-emptive and preferential rights of subscription to any shares of stock of the corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized, or to any obligations convertible into stock of the corporation, or to obligations of the corporation convertible into stock. Any stock or obligations issued by the corporation shall first be offered to the stockholders of the corporation.

ELEVENTH

A voluntary sale, lease or exchange of all of the property and assets of the corporation, including its good will and its corporate franchises, may be made by the Board of Directors upon such terms and conditions as it may deem expedient for the best interests of the corporation, but only when such act is authorized by the vote of holders of two-thirds of voting power of all shareholders.

TWELFTH |

No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation and no act of the corporation shall in any

way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, or are directors or officers of such other corporation, any director individually, or any firm of which any director may be a member, may be a party to, or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided that the fact that he or such firm is so interested shall be disclosed of shall have been known to bhe Board of Directors or a majority thereof, and any director of the corporation who is also a director or office of such other corporation, or who is so interested, may be counted in determing the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize any such contract or any such transaction with like force and effect as if he were not such director or officer of such other corporation or not so interested.

THIRTEENTH

The Board of Directors is expressly authorized to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and to adopt new By-Laws, and the corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal, any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in the manner now, or hereafter, prescribed by law, by a majority vote of the stockholders, represented in person or by proxy, at any meeting duly called for that purpose, except where the laws of the said State of Idaho otherwise provide.
