The undersigned, President and Secretary of Our Saviors Lutheran Church, a religious corporation, hereby certify that at a special meeting of the members of said corporation held in the Church parlors on the 5th day of July, 1955, duly and regularly advertised as required by Idaho Code section 30-1103, the following resolution was adopted by the unanimous consent of the members of said corporation present at such meeting,

"THE CORPORATION IS TO HAVE PERPETUAL EXISTENCE"

NOTICE OF INTENTION

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given of the intention of Our Savior's Lutheran Church of Moscow, Idaho, to amend article four of the Articles of Incorporation.

That the matters and things concerning and connected with as well as relative to making such amendment will be taken up, considered and voted upon by the members of said corporation to be held at the church of said corporation, situated at the corner of Sixth and Jefferson streets in the City of Moscow, Idaho, the 5th day of July, 1955, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. of said last mentioned date.

That it is proposed to amend article four of its Articles of Incorporation so that the same shall read and be as follows: The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

The object of petitioning for such a change is that the fifty year existence of said corporation expired on October 6, 1954, and it is desired that the corporate existence be perpetual.


