

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, OF SALUBRIA LODGE NUMBER THIRTY ONE
ANCIENT FREE AND ACCEPTED MASONS.

Know All Men By These Presents; That we the undersigned,
for ourselves, and for the persons hereinafter, in paragraph VI
of these articles of incorporation, named, constituting the entire
membership of Salubria Lodge Number thirty one, A-F & A-M, and
acknowledging the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Ancient Free
and Accepted Masons of the State of Idaho, have this day associated
ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws
of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify:

-I-

That the name of this corporation is, " Salubria Lodge No. 31,
A.F. & A.M.

-II-

That the purposes for which it is formed is to conduct and
maintain a Lodge of Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons. in accordance
with the laws, usages and customs thereof, under the Jurisdiction of
The Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of the State of
Idaho,; to take over, hold, purchase, sell, mortgage or dispose of
such real estate as may be necessary for the purposes of a hall or
Meeting place, and to carry out its charitable purposes, or for the
establishment and endowment of institutions of learning connected
therewith.

That the place where its principal business is to be trans-
acted is in the City of CAMBRIDGE, County of Washington, State of
Idaho.

-IV-

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and
after the date of its incorporation.

-V-

That the number of trustees shall be three, and the names and
residences of those who are elected to serve untill the 27th day

of December, A D 1902, are as follows, to-wit;

That said trustees were duly elected at a meeting of said Salubria Lodge No 31, A F & A M., duly called for that purpose and notice thereof having been previously given, pursuant to the rules, ordinances and customs governing the same, at the hall of said Lodge, in the Odd Fellows building, in the town of Salubria, County of Washington, State of Idaho, on Wednesday evening, the 18th day of June, 1902,; That a majority of all the members of said Lodge were present, and voted at said election, for the above named trustees, as is more particularly set fourth in the certificate and verification of the officers who conducted the election, herunto annexed and made a part of these articles of incorporation.
