19 65, a properly authenticated copy of its articles of incorporation, and on the First

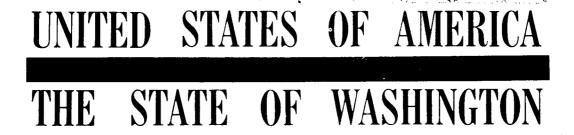

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#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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# TEKOA GROWERS, INC.

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, the undersigned, L. R. Woods, E. Gaffney, Sam Tyler and J. F. Hansen (each of whom is a citizen of the United States of America) have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Laws of the State of Washington and in pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate originals and state as follows:

### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be TEKOA GROWERS, INC.
ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business of the corporation and the objects and purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted and carried on by it are as follows:

To buy, sell, store and otherwise handle and deal in grain, hay, seeds, feeds, fertilizers, weed chemicals and insecticides, cleaning, treating and processing of seeds, treating and processing of feeds, and any related matters, and generally to do a grain storage business and to buy, sell, mortgage, lease and deal in real estate and personal property including grain elevators, warehouses, cribs, and other real and personal property in and about its business, to borrow money and giving evidences of its indebtedness therefor, and to do and perform any and all acts and things as may be necessary and incidental in and about the carrying on of the business above described in all its phases.

## ARTICLE III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE IV

The registered office of the corporation is to be located at Tekoa, Whitman County, Washington.

#### ARTICLE V

The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), consisting of one thousand (1000) shares of Common Stock having a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

#### ARTICLE VI

The amount of paid-in capital with which this corporation shall begin business is the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

#### ARTICLE VII

The management of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors who shall be stockholders; the number of Directors shall not be less than three nor more than twelve and the numbers, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and powers and duties of the Directors shall be such as are prescribed by the By-laws of the corporation.

# ARTICLE VIII

The authority to make By-laws for the corporation is hereby expressly vested in the stockholders of this corporation.

#### ARTICLE IX

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred on the stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

#### ARTICLE X
