FIRST, The name of the Corporation as aforesaid; SECOND, The purpose for which it was formed; THIRD, The place where its principal business is to be transacted; FOURTH, The term for which it is to exist; FIFTH, The number of its directors or trustees; SIXTH, The amount of its capital stock and the number of shares into which it is divided; SEVENTH, The amount of its capital stock actually subscribed and by whom.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name stated in the articles, for the term of fifty years.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE VALLEY MARKET.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS : That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the state of Idaho.

And we hereby certify:

First. That the name of said corporation is Valley Market.

Second. That the purposes for which it is formed are to carry on the business of a meat market and grocery store, to buy or raise live-stock to butcher and sell the meat from, to buy and sell ready dressed meats and generally to dal all things usually donee in connection with a retail meat market and grocery store.

Third. That the place where it's principal business is to be transacted shall be the Village of Meridian, County of Ada.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of it's incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of It's directors shall be three and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are.
