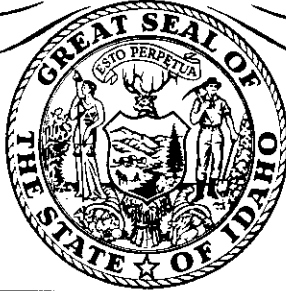

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

The undersigned, William G. Magers, President and R. N. Chrisman, Secretary-Treasurer, of H. I. P. of Idaho, Inc., an Idaho corporation, do hereby certify and respectfully represent as follows:

That H. I. P. Of Idaho, Inc. was duly organized under the laws of the State of Idaho on the 27th day of April, 1964; that a meeting of the stockholders of H. I. P. Of Idaho, Inc. was duly called by the Secretary-Treasurer of the corporation by giving written notice thereof more than thirty days prior to the date set for such meeting to each stockholder, and that each stockholder of the corporation personally appeared and attended said meeting held on the 20 day of July, 1967, at Springfield, Missouri, and each stockholder remained in attendance throughout the said meeting and acted therein; that by the unanimous vote of those present at said meeting, there was adopted a resolution amending the Articles of Incorporation as hereinafter set forth.

That the resolution adopted by the stockholders amending the Articles of Incorporation is as follows:

RESOLVED, that, whereas, the amount or number of shares heretofore authorized by the Articles of Incorporation is the sum of 1000 shares at a par value of \$100.00 per share, or an authorized capitalization of \$100,000.00, and

RESOLVED, that, whereas, the stockholders desire to increase the authorized capital stock of the corporation by the amount of \$200,000.00 with the number of authorized shares to be 3000 with a par value of \$100.00 per share, and

RESOLVED, that Article V of the Articles of Incorporation of H.I.P. Of Idaho, Inc. be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE V.

That the total authorized capital stock of said corporation shall be Three hundred thousand and no/100 (\$300,000.00) Dollars, divided into three thousand(3000) shares of the par value of One hundred and no/100(\$100.00) Dollars each, and all of said capital stock shall be common stock.
