#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 10 of the Idaho Code and Acts amendatory thereto and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

#### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be "LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF IDAHO, INC."

#### ARTICLE II

The purposes and objects for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

- A. To promote political responsibility through informed and active participation of citizens in government.
- B. To take action on state governmental measures and policies in the public interest in conformity with the principles of the League of Women Voters of the United States. This corporation shall not support or oppose any political party or candidate.
- C. To make and adopt a constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations for the admission, suspension and expulsion of its members and for their government; for the election and appointment of directors and other officers and definitions of their duties and for the safekeeping and protection of its property and funds and in general to regulate, manage and preserve its property interests

and from time to time alter, repeal, rescind or amend by-laws, rules, regulations or any of them.

- D. The Corporation shall have the power to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease or otherwise, either absolutely or in trust, for any of its purposes, any property, real or personal, insofar as the same may be held by a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and acts amendatory and supplemental thereto, and to convey, sell, mortgage, or dispose of such property and to invest and reinvest the principal and deal with and expend the income therefrom in such manner as may be permitted by law, and as in the judgment of the directors will best promote the objects for which the corporation is organized.
- E. The corporation may do all and everything, including the making and carrying out of any contracts, necessary, suitable or proper, for the accomplishment of any of the purposes and objects or the furtherance of any of the powers above set forth and it may do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or pertaining to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid purposes or powers or any parts thereof, provided the same are not in conflict with the corporation laws of the State of Idaho.
- F. The corporation hereby formed is not organized and shall not be further conducted for the purposes directly or indirectly of fixing the price or regulating production of any article of commerce, or product of the soil, or of consumption by the people.

#### ARTICLE III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be at 2825 Westmoreland Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho.

#### ARTICLE V

The rights and interests of all members of the corporation shall be equal and no member shall have, nor shall such member acquire a greater interest therein than any other member; that membership in the corporation shall not be assigned in any manner so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the board of directors and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe; that the number and qualification of the members, the terms and conditions of admission, the fees for admission, the assessment of dues to carry on the business of the association, and other regulations consonant with the objects of the corporation, and not repugnant to the laws of the State of Idaho shall be as prescribed by the by-laws.

#### ARTICLE VI

#### ARTICLE VII

That the names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors are as set forth in Article VI.

#### ARTICLE VIII

The number of persons named above shall constitute the number of directors of the corporation until changed by an amendment to the By-laws, increasing or decreasing the number of directors as may be desired. The directors shall be elected for such term as shall be provided for in the By-laws.

#### ARTICLE IX

The executive officers of the corporation shall be a President, a First Vice-President, a Second Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The corporation may have such other officers as may be designated in the By-laws. Such executive officers shall be elected at the conventions of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE X

The right to repeal and amend By-laws or to adopt new By-laws shall be as fixed by the By-laws.
