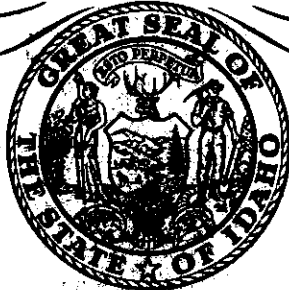

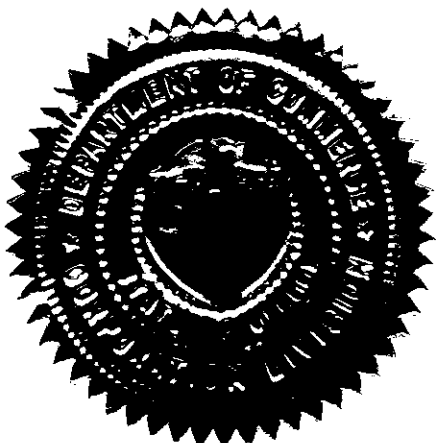

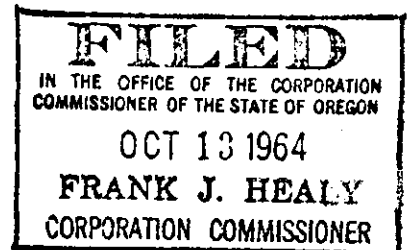

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE INLAND DEVELOPMENT COMPANY



We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, acting as incorporators under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is THE INLAND DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under Chapter 57, Oregon Revised Statutes.

ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is two thousand five hundred (2,500) shares without par value.

ARTICLE IV

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 5 Greenwood Avenue, Bend, Oregon, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is H. A. Miller.

ARTICLE V

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is three (3). The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors shall be elected and qualified are:
