CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of GREENWOOD AVENUE IRRIGATION COMPANY, Limited.

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We, the undersigned Arthur Wheat and Annabel Anderson, respectively President and Secretary of the Greenwood Avenue Irrigation Company, Limited, a non-profit corporation, do hereby certify that at a meeting of the Board of Directors of said corporation duly called and held in the city of Payette, County of Payette, State of Idaho, on the 11th day of March, 1958, at g:OOP.M., at which meeting a quorum of Directors was present in person, the following resolution was adopted by more than a two-thirds majority of said Directors --

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That, whereas, the corporation was notified by letter dated the 13th day of February, 1958, from the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho that the corporate existence of the Greenwood Avenue Irrigation Company, Limited, expired on the 16th day of April, 1956, and, whereas, it is the desire of said corporation to continue to operate as a corporation for a period of perpetual existence; Now, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED By a two-thirds vote of said Directors that the extension of the Articles of Incorporation for a perpetual existence will be for the best interests of the stockholders and that Tuesday the 22 day of April , 19**58**, at <u>{</u> :00 P.M., at louse, County Court House, is hereby fixed as the time and place for the holding of a Directors' meeting, at which time the question of the proposed extension of the corporate existence of said corporation will be finally voted upon by the Directors of said corporation; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That a notice of the time and place of said Directors' meeting shall be given at least thirty days prior to such meeting by mailing to each of the stockholders shown on the books of the corporation at his last known mailing address, said notice to comply with Idaho Code 30-160, and said notice to be mailed by the Secretary to each stockholder, and said notice also to be published at least once a week for four successive weeks prior to said meeting in the Independent-Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in Payette County; and BE IT FUR-THER RESOLVED That the Board of Directors re-convene on Tuesday , 1958, at & :00 P.M., at April 20 April the 12 day of then and there to determine whether or not the proposed extension of corporate existence of said corporation shall be authorized.

That thereafter Annabel Anderson, Secretary of said corporation, sent the following notice to each stockholder of said corporation at least thirty days prior to the said scheduled meeting, at his last known address as shown on the books of the Greenwood Avenue Irrigation Company, Limited.

You will please take notice that on the 11th day of March, 1958, by a two-thirds vote of the Directors of Greenwood Avenue Irrigation Company, Limited, a resolution was passed that an extension of the corporate existence of said corporation is to the best interests of the corporation and of the stockholders, and that the time and of the Stockholders, and that the stockholders, and the stockh

voted upon by the Directors of said corporation, and that thirty days have lapsed since the 11th day of March, 1958.

It is the intention of the Directors, at the abovestated time and place to vote upon a proposed extension of the corporate existence of the Greenwood Avenue Irrigation Company, Limited, to allow the corporation to exist perpetually inasmuch as the term of the corporate existence has now expired. You are further notified that as a stockholder you have the right to object to the proposed extension of the corporate existence. You are further notified that any stockholder may appear at the Directors' meeting, in person or by written proxy filed at the time of the meeting, and make an objection to the proposed extension, but unless stockholders representing one-third of the capital stock of the corporation or one-third of the members make objection to such proposed extension at or prior to said meeting, in one or more of the methods above specified, then the Board of Directors may at said meeting, by resolution adopted by at least a two-thirds majority vote of such board, make such extension as proposed.

It is necessary to extend the charter of this corporation as the same has now expired.
