


ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

VALLEY SECURITY INC.



I, the undersigned, to form a corporation under the Idaho
Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Ι

The name of the corporation is VALLEY SECURITY INC.

ΙI

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is for the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, Title 30 of the Idaho Code.

IV

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is ten thousand (10,000) shares of common stock, having no par value per share. Each of such shares shall be non-assessable when fully paid for.

Each share of stock shall be entitled to one vote in all matters wherein the shareholders of the corporation shall be entitled to vote, and each share shall, in all respects, be equal to every other share. There shall be no cumulative voting allowed by the shareholders on any issues that may become before it.

The capital stock shall be transferred in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be established by the Bylaws of the corporation, and all restrictions relative to the transfer of shares of stock of the corporation shall be specifically noted on the stock certificates issues by the corporation.

A director shall not be personally liable to the corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director, provided that such personal liability shall not be limited for any of the following acts:

- a) For any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the corporation or to its stockholders.
- b) For acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law.
- c) For those acts or omissions more particularly set forth in which involve director liability as provided in Idaho Code section 30-1-48, which states, in pertinent part, that a director shall be liable under the following circumstances:

- 1. If the director votes for or assents to the declaration of any dividend or other distribution of the assets of a corporation to its shareholders contrary to the provisions of the Idaho General Business Corporations Act.
- 2. If the director votes for or assents to the purchase of the corporation's own shares contrary to the provisions of the Idaho General Business Corporations Act.
- 3. If the director votes for or assents to any distribution of assets of the corporation to its shareholders during the liquidation of the corporation without the payment and discharge of, or making adequate provisions for, all known debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation.
- 4. For any transaction from which the director derives an improper personal benefit.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being all of the incorporators hereinbefore named, do hereby make this certificate for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the provisions of Title 30, Idaho Code, and do hereby certify that the facts hereinbefore set forth are true and correct.
