I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

H & S TRANSPORTATION CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Idaho, this day have voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and we do hereby certify as follows:

I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be H & S TRANSPORTATION CO.

II

PURPOSE

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) To engage in the business of transporting persons and property for hire, in or between the various states, by motor vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, and other means of conveyance, and to acquire, own, operate, lease, and dispose of like businesses; to buy, sell, lease and deal in motors, automobiles, motor trucks, trailers, and airplanes and their appliances, fuels and accessories; to operate and maintain garages, and service stations and terminal freight points, and to store, repair, rent and lease motors, automobiles, motor trucks, trailers, and airplanes and other vehicles, and to do generally all and every other thing necessary and incident to the business of a transportation company.

(b) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease (either as lessor or as lessee), sell, exchange, subdivide, mortgage and generally operate any real or personal property of any and every kind or description, within or without the State of Idaho, necessary, suitable or useful in connection with any of the objects or purposes herein set forth.

(c) To construct and erect buildings or structures upon and to improve and maintain any and all real property owned, leased or held by this corporation; and to equip, improve, and generally operate any and all personal property owned by this corporation.

(d) To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock; provided, it shall not use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such use would cause any impairment of its capital; and provided, further, that the shares of its own capital stock owned by it shall not be voted upon directly or indirectly.

(e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary or desirable for the furtherance of the business of this corporation, with any persons, firms, corporation, associations, any state, territory, government or body politic.

(f) To acquire, and hold all or any part of the capital stock, assets or good will of any business, or any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in any business in whole or in part similar to that of this corporation, consistent with the objects and purposes of this corporation, and to hold, utilize and in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the stock, assets, good will and rights so acquired and to conduct in any lawful manner in whole or in part any business so acquired, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in the business so acquired.

(g) To borrow money for any purpose of this corporation, without limit as to amount, and to issue bonds, debentures, notes or other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured, of this corporation for the moneys so borrowed, or in payment for this property acquired, or for any other objects or purposes of this corporation, or in connection with its business; to secure payment of such debentures, notes or other obligations by mortgages, or deeds of trust or pledged or other liens upon any or all of the property of this corporation wheresoever situated.

(h) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects or purposes as principal or agent, or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with any person, association or other corporation and in any part of the world; and in carrying on its business and for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects or purposes, to make and perform such contracts of any kind and description, to do such acts and such things, and to exercise any and all such powers as a natural person could lawfully make, perform, do or exercise, provided that the same be not inconsistent with the objects or purposes of this corporation, or the statutes of the State of Idaho.

(i) To conduct its business in all or any of its branches in the State of Idaho and in any and all other states, territories, possessions, colonies and dependencies of the United States of America and in the District of Columbia, and in any or all foreign countries, and to have one or more offices within or outside of the State of Idaho.

(j) The objects as specified herein shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or influence from the terms or any other clause or paragraph of these Articles. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses or paragraphs in these Articles shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.

### III

#### DURATION

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

### IV

#### REGISTERED OFFICE

The principal place of business and registered office of this corporation shall be at Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

### V

#### STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares of stock, the total number of which is 100 with a par value of \$100.00, which stock may be issued by the corporation from time to time as determined by the Board of Directors.

### VI

#### DIRECTORS

The number of directors shall be not less than three nor more than seven, as may be provided by the By-Laws of the corporation.
