I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

One Thousand Nine Hundred **Twenty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **81** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 20-103 and Sections 20-1001 to 20-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Idaho** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit cooperative Associations, as provided in Chapter 10, Title 20, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
KOOSKIA SADDLIERS, INC.

KOOSKIA, IDAHO

We, the undersigned, all of legal age, and all being citizens of the United States of America, have associated, and do hereby associate ourselves together for the forming of a non-profit cooperative association as a corporation, under the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30, of the Idaho Code, and for that purpose do hereby certify as follows:

I

The name of this corporation shall be KOOSKIA SADDLIERS, INC.

II

The purposes of this corporation shall be: to promote and encourage active interest in horsemanship, and all matters incidental thereto, including, but not exclusively, the breeding and raising of horses of all types and breeds; to develop and promote the dissemination of information and all matters of interest related to the purposes of the corporation; to encourage among the members of the corporation, active interest in its purposes, a friendly spirit of mutual cooperation, and closer personal acquaintance; to foster and cultivate social, educational and business relationships among the members of the corporation; to forward and promote the general welfare of the members, and thus to improve by any lawful and honorable means, the individual status and condition of each; and to do all of such things, in the interest of the development of good moral character and a normal desire and ambition on the part of the members, to improve themselves, and to help each other.

III

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, except as the same may be limited by law.

IV

The principal place of business and the registered office of the corporation, shall be at Kooskia, Idaho County, Idaho, but other places of business and other offices may be established elsewhere, as may be determined by the directors of the corporation.

V

This corporation shall have no capital stock, and shall not engage in business for profit, and if any of the activities of the corporation result in income over and above its expenses, such income shall be used for the purposes and in accord with the stated aims of the corporation, and shall never inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual member or members of the organization. **This corporation shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, and the rights and interests of all members shall be equal.**

VI

Except as limited by these Articles and by law, this corporation shall have and exercise all the powers granted to business corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, including the acquisition, ownership, sale or trading, mortgaging and leasing of real and personal property, limited only to the purposes of the corporation as hereinbefore set forth.

VII

The officers of this corporation shall be a president, a vice president, a secretary and a treasurer, and such other officers as the directors may determine necessary for the accomplishment of the corporate aims and purposes. The duties of such officers and the manner in which the objects and purposes of the corporation shall be carried out, shall be such as are provided in the by-laws of the organization.
