ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

3 11 7 10 46

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, being three or more natural persons of full age, all citizens of the United States and residents of the state of Idaho, have associated, and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming an ex-servicemen's corporate organization under the provisions of Section 30, Chapter 2 of the Idaho Code.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be (the) Southeast Idaho Freedom Ring, Inc. Its principal office for the transaction of business shall be Pocatello, Idaho.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation shall exist perpetually, or until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE THREE

This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade or commerce, nor directly or indirectly, fix the price, or regulate the production, of any article of commerce or the produce of the soil, or the consumption of the same by the people, nor carry on any activity which will result in a remunerative profit to the corporation or its members. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the business, pursuit, purpose and objects of this corporation are fraternal, patriotic, historical and educational; to preserve and strengthen comradeship among its members; to assist worthy comrades; to perpetuate the memory and history of our dead, and to assist their widows and orphans; to maintain true allegiance to the Government of the United States of America, and fidelity to its Constitution and laws; to foster true patriotism; to maintain and extend the institutions of American freedom; and to preserve and defend the United States from all her enemies, whenever.

ARTICLE FOUR

The corporation will have members as defined in the D.-Laws.

ARTICLE FIVE

In the event of dissolution of this corporation, all of the assets shall be distributed to charitable non-profit institutions as defined by federal and state law and rules and regulations of the IRS and the Idaho State Tax Commission.

## ARTICLE SIX

All meetings shall be conducted in no other language than the English language.

## ARTICLE SEVEN

The general officers of the corporation shall be as provided in the By-Laws. The number of directors shall be not less than three.

## ARTICLE EIGHT

All other matters pertaining to the organization and operation of the corporation not herein provided for shall be determined and fixed by the By-Laws.
