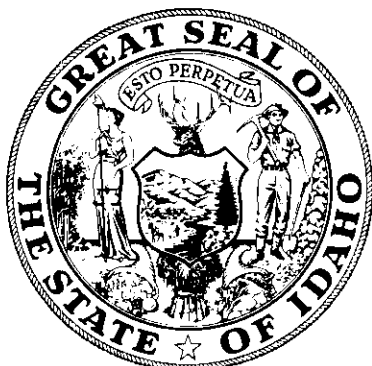

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that HERBERT L. JACOBSON, being over the age of twenty-one years, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, does hereby certify and adopt in duplicate the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be INGAS, INC., and its existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(1) To conduct a business of buying, distributing and selling propane and other fuels and automotive and truck parts and equipment, and kindred supplies and accessories;

(2) To buy, own, sell, lease and in any manner handle any and all types of equipment pertinent to its business;

(3) To buy, own, sell or lease any and all types of real or personal property which may be necessary or convenient in the operation of its business;

(4) To borrow money and to issue as evidence therefor its notes, mortgages, bonds or other instruments that may be necessary or convenient in connection therewith; in fact, to do any and all

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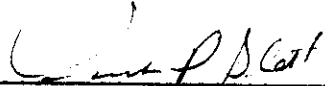
