KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being the President and Clerk respectively of the CLASSIS OF CALIFORNIA, REFORMED CHURCH IN AMERICA, an unincorporated association, for the purpose of incorporating said unincorporated association as a corporation under the laws of the State of California and by the authority of the said unincorporated association, hereby certify:

I

The name of the corporation to be formed herein shall be the CLASSIS OF CALIFORNIA, REFORMED CHURCH IN AMERICA.

II

That the purposes for which the Corporation is formed are: For the administration and management of the property and estate of said church; to contract in the same manner and to the same extent as a natural person, to sue and be sued and defend in all courts and places in all matters and proceedings whatsoever; to borrow money and give promissory notes therefor and to secure the payment thereof by mortgages, deeds of trust, or other liens on the property of said corporation, either real or personal, as well as, lease, mortgage and deal in real and personal property, to maintain a place of worship and to conduct worship according to the usages and practice of the Reformed Church in America; to do any and all things proper and necessary for the business and objects of the corporation and not inconsistent with the laws of the State of California governing such corporations, and to do them in any and all parts of the world.

That it is a corporation which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

III

That the County in this State where the principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is located is Los Angeles County.

IV
