ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, STEVEN E. CLAYTON, of Sun Valley, Blaine County, Idaho, being a person of full age and citizens of the United States of America, do hereby, as incorporator thereof, form a corporation under the provisions of the laws of the State of Idaho, and hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation of such corporation as follows:

I.

That the name of said corporation is Emerson Investment Corporation.

II.

That the purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is for the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated.

III.

That the duration of said corporation shall be perpetual.

IV.

That the location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation in Idaho shall be Suite 203, Walnut Avenue Mall, Ketchum, Idaho 83340. Branch offices or places of business of said corporation may be hereafter established at any other place, either within or without the State of Idaho, whenever necessary, or in the judgment of the Board of Directors, for the proper prosecution of the objects and purposes of said corporation.

That the registered Agent of said corporation in Idaho shall be STEVEN E. CLAYTON, Post Office Box 1526, Sun Valley, Idaho 83353.

That the shares of stock of said corporation are not to be classified and shall all be common stock, and that the authorized shares of said corporation shall be TWENTY-FIVE THOU-SAND (25,000) in number, of the par value of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS each, and of the aggregate par value of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$250,000.00) DOLLARS. Each issued share of common stock shall be entitled to one vote and shall represent all the voting shares of the corporation.

VI.

That the number of directors of said corporation shall be fixed by the by-laws of the corporation; provided, however, said corporation shall have not less than one (1) nor more than seven (7) directors. The first Board of Directors shall be one (1) in number consisting of STEVEN E. CLAYTON, who shall serve until the annual election of directors in the year 1987.

VII.

That the qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting and the powers and duties of the Directors of the Corporation shall be prescribed by the by-laws:

That the Directors of the Corporation shall have the power and authority to alter, repeal, and amend the by-laws and adopt new by-laws of the corporation in the manner fixed by the by-laws of the corporation.

VIII.
