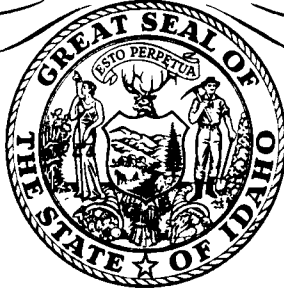

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

GRACE COMMUNITY CHURCH OF CALDWELL, IDAHO., INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Sixteenth** day of **July** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-five** and **will be** duly recorded on **Film No. / microfilm** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Caldwell,** in the County of **Canyon,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
GRACE COMMUNITY CHURCH OF CALDWELL, IDAHO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the members of Grace Community Church of Caldwell, Idaho, have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho and for such purpose do hereby certify and declare as follows:

ARTICLE ONE

That the name of this corporation shall be, and is, Grace Community Church of Caldwell, Idaho., Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The purpose of this corporation is to maintain, conduct and foster a local church, independent of any other church or church organization, for the purpose of preaching and teaching the word of Jesus Christ as taught by the Scriptures set forth in the Holy Bible and to represent Jesus Christ upon this earth in obeying His word in all things and to aid in carrying out the Great Commission in teaching the gospel to every creature, and to baptize those seeking admission to our church in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit by immersion, and to administer the Lord's Supper, and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The said corporation may acquire, own, hold, manage, and dispose of such parcel or parcels of real estate, together with such buildings and improvements as may be deemed necessary

or desirable for and in connection with any of the purposes of the corporation, and may own, operate, maintain, and manage such buildings for public worship, religious meetings, education, and instruction as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this corporation; and may construct, erect, purchase or otherwise acquire, maintain and operate churches, parsonages and other church buildings and facilities; and may sell or otherwise dispose of or exchange for other property, real or personal, all property acquired by the corporation not longer deemed necessary for its purposes, and may borrow money and incur indebtedness for the purposes of the corporation, and may issue bonds, notes, mortgages, or deeds of trust to evidence or secure the same and may receive, hold, invest, expend and apply for the purposes of the corporation, or any of them, gifts, contributions, pledges, offerings, devises and bequests of money or property; to establish a constitution of by-laws and make all rules and regulations deemed necessary and expedient for the management of the corporation and its affairs in accordance with law, and not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation. The foregoing enumeration of powers shall not be deemed or construed to be exclusive of, or a limitation upon, such other and general powers permitted or granted by law, which are in keeping with, or in aid of, the general purposes of the corporation; PROVIDED, however, that the corporation shall not hold or own more real estate than may be necessary for the business and objects of the corporation.

ARTICLE FOUR

That there shall be a Board of Trustees consisting of three (3) members, which Board shall be charged with the management of the property, both real and personal, of the corporation; and said Trustees shall purchase such property, and make such other agreements respecting the same, only as they may be directed to do so by the members of the corporation, and such direction shall be given by a vote at any meeting of the members of the corporation called for such purpose, and by at least a two-thirds (2/3rds) majority vote of said members present. The first Trustees duly elected are:

Said Trustees shall hold office during the term or terms as may be provided for in the Constitution or By-Laws of the said corporation.

ARTICLE FIVE

That this corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE SIX

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and it shall not have or issue any capital stock. Membership in the corporation shall not entitle a person to any interest whatsoever in the assets of the corporation, but only to participate in the management of the affairs of the corporation, in meetings of the members legally called and held within the period covered by the membership.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The members of this corporation shall not be subject to assessments for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting

business or paying debts of the corporation, or for any other purpose.

ARTICLE EIGHT

That the principal place of business and registered office of this corporation shall be in the City of Caldwell, County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE NINE

That in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-1102 Idaho Code, a meeting of the members of said church was held for the purpose of, among other things, electing a Board of three (3) Trustees for this corporation; that said election was held on Thursday, June 10, 1965, at 1217 Fillmore Street, at Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho; that notice of said election was duly given in accordance with said section and for the length of time as required therein; that a copy of said notice, attached to proof of the publication thereof in the Caldwell News-Tribune, a newspaper printed and of general circulation in Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho, is attached hereto and filed with these Articles; that a majority of the members of said church who were present at said meeting voted at such election; that Jackie Williams was elected to act as Chairman and Harriett E. Coulter was elected to act as secretary at said meeting; and that at and by such election the persons whose names and addresses are hereinafter set forth were duly elected Trustees and to comprise the Board of said Trustees of said corporation until such time as successors are elected or appointed as provided for in the Constitution or By-Laws of said corporation, and further the said Trustees were directed, by resolution duly passed, to incorporate said association under the laws of the State of Idaho.
