ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of the

IDAHO TIMES PUBLISHING CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, F. W.

Lampkin, E. B. Aldrich, Lee D. Drake and J. S. Harvey, all

being residents of the State of Oregon and each and all

being citizens of the United States, do hereby associate

ourselves for the purpose of forming a private corporation

under and by virtue of the general incorporation laws of

the State of Oregon and do hereby adopt the following

Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name assumed by this corporation and by which it shall be known and under which it shall act shall be IDAHO TIMES PUBLISHING CO.

ARTICLE II.

The duration of this corporation shall be unlimited.

ARTICLE III.

The enterprise, business, pursuit and occupation for which this corporation is organized and in which it purposes to engage is:

To acquire, print, publish, conduct and circulate or otherwise deal with any newspaper or newspapers or other publication and generally to carry on the business of newspaper proprietors and general publishers; to carry on, if and when it shall deem desirable the trade or business as general printers, book sellers, book binders, stationers, photographers, photographic printers, stereotypers, electrotypers, lithographers and advertising agents to publish, distribute and broadcast news of the day, advertising matter and other information in which the public has an interest, by

printing, telephoning, telegraphing and radio broadcasting the same, or by any other method which may now or hereafter exist for the distribution and dissemination of any
matter in which the general public may have an interest and,
in connection therewith, to build, construct, erect, purchase,
hire or otherwise acquire or provide any buildings, offices,
workshops, plants or other things necessary or useful for the
purpose of carrying out the objects of this corporation.

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares and merchandise and real and personal property of every class and description.

To acquire, and pay for in each, stock or bonds of this corporation or otherwise, the good will, rights, assets and property, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation.

To acquire, hold, use, sell, assign, lease, grant licenses in respect of, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of letters patent of the United States or any foreign country, patent rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, improvements and processes, copyrights, trade-marks and trade names, relating to or useful in connection with any business of this corporation.

To guarantee, purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidence of indebtedness created by any other corporation or corporations organized under the laws of this state or any other state, country, nation or government, and while the owner thereof to exercise

all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership.

To issue bonds, debentures or obligations of and in the credit of this corporation from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of the corporation, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or otherwise.

of its operations and business and without restriction or limit as to amount to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, mortgage, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description in any of the States, Districts, Territories or Colonies of the United States, and in any and all foreign countries, subject to the laws of such State, District, Territory, Colony or Country.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, whether manufacturing or otherwise, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of Oregon upon such corporations, and to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV.

The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be in Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon.

ARTICLE V.

The capital stock of this comporation shall be \$30,000.00, divided into three hundred (300) shares of the par

value of \$100.00 each.
