ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE  
GOODING COUNTY MOTORCYCLE ASSOCIATION, INC.

Know ALL Men By These Presents: That we, the undersigned, Being five natural persons and citizens and bonafide residents of the State of Idaho, Have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

That the name of said corporation shall be:

GOODING COUNTY MOTORCYCLE ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) To promote the use of motorcycles for recreation and pleasure by the members of the corporation and the general public.

(b) To cooperate with all law enforcement officers in the enforcement of all motor vehicle and traffic laws, ordinances and regulations.

(c) To affiliate or associate with other similiar associations or organizations of a state or national kind and such organizations within the state of Idaho.

(d) To purchase, hold, convey, mortgage and encumber real and property and to borrow money with or without securing the same property of the corporation as the purposes of the corporation may require.

(e) To organize, promote and advertise safety and educational campaigns in the use of the highways of this State; especially in the use of motorcycles and similiar vehicles.

(f) To carry on and promote any undertakings which are calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of this corporation and generally to have, engage in and exercise all the rights, powers and privileges which have now or may hereafter be conferred upon non-profitable corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to do all things necessary, suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of the purposes and this to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do.

#### ARTICLE III

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of its registered office in this State and its principle place of business shall be at Hagerman, Gooding County, Idaho.

#### ARTICLE V

This corporation is a non-profit sharing membership corporation without capital stock. All persons interested in the purposes of this corporation as hereinbefore set forth shall, upon election to membership and unanimous approval of the board of directors be admitted for membership. Voting of the board of directors will be by secret ballot. The rights and interests of all members of this corporation shall be equal. This corporation shall not issue any capital stock but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transfer can, by such transfer become a member of the corporation, except by the resolution of the board of directors and under such regulations as

the by-laws may prescribe. No member may have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

ARTICLE VI

The number of directors of this corporation shall be five, and the post office addresses of the directors who are to act in the capacity of directors until the election of their successors are:
