CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

JOHNSTON RADIO COMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATION, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-sixth** day of **October,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and is duly recorded on Film No. **121** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls** in the County of **Bonneville** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
JOHNSTON RADIO COMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of adult age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I.

The name of the corporation shall be JOHNSTON RADIO COMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATION, INC.

II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

1. The corporation shall furnish and render a non-profit radio communication service to Johnston Pump Company, Inc., a California Corporation with principal office at Pasadena, California, qualified to do business in the State of Idaho, with principal office in Idaho Falls, Idaho, or to any other subsidiary of Johnston Pump Company, Inc., so long as said company, or subsidiary, shall be engaged in a commercial activity.
2. The corporation shall not engage in any business, trade, avocation or profession for gain or profit.
3. The corporation shall have power to do all things necessary, and essential, convenient, or proper for the accomplishment of any and all of the aforementioned purposes, or the attainment of any and all of the objects above mentioned, or objects and purposes incident to the powers herein named, or objects or purposes which shall at any time appear to be conducive, or expedient, or beneficial to the corporation, and to such end to have any and all powers conferred upon non-profit cooperative associations organized under the Statutes of the State of Idaho.

III.

Subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV.

The principal place of business, registered office, location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation shall be Box 556, Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho.

V.

This corporation shall not issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof. These certificates of membership cannot be assigned to permit the transferee thereof, by such transfer, to become a member of the association except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the By-Laws of this corporation may prescribe. The rights and interests of all members of this association shall be equal and no member shall have or acquire a greater interest than any other member. Membership shall be limited to Johnston Pump Company, Inc., or any other subsidiary of Johnston Pump Company, Inc., and only on condition that said company or subsidiary, shall be engaged in a commercial activity. The Board of Directors is hereby empowered to authorize the issuance of membership certificates from time to time within the limits authorized by these articles and the By-Laws.

VI.

No alien may serve as an officer or member of the Board of Directors of this corporation. The number of directors of said corporation shall be three (3) to be elected annually. Such number may be increased pursuant to the By-Laws of the corporation. The names of the directors who shall so act until the first annual meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and qualify are: Ralph F. Johnson, Bert H. Hansen and Reed L. Moss.

VII.

The corporation reserves the right from time to time to make any amendment of its charter, now or hereafter authorized by law.


