ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE
TITLE INSURANCE COMPANY FOUNDATION, INC.

Be it known, that The Title Insurance Company Foundation, Inc., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, does hereby make and execute the following Articles of Amendment and does hereby certify in accordance with the provisions of Title 30, Idaho Code as follows:

1. That a regular meeting of the Members of the Foundation was duly called, convened and held in the manner provided by law and by the By-Laws of said corporation, and was duly advertised to the public in accordance with Section 30-1103, I.C. as established by a copy of the Affidavit of Publication attached hereto marked Exhibit A, and made a part hereof, on the 14th day of August, 1972, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. at the principal office of the Foundation at 711 Bannock Street, Boise, Idaho, and by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Members of the Foundation at said meeting, the following resolution was adopted:

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Articles of Incorporation of The Title Insurance Company Foundation, Inc., be, and the same hereby are, amended by adding thereto a new Article XVI as follows:

"ARTICLE XVI

"(a) The corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

"(b) The corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

- "(c) The corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
- "(d) The corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
- "(e) The corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

AN BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the President and Secretary of the Foundation be, and they hereby are, directed and empowered to cause a proper Certificate of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation to be executed and filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho in compliance with the statutes of the State in such case made and provided."
