ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE PEOPLES CHURCH OF COEUR D'ALENE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

that we, the undersigned, all citizens and residents of the United States of America and of the State of Idaho, of legal age, acting as incorporators of a non-profit religious corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho, do adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be

THE PEOPLES CHURCH OF COEUR D'ALENE, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The object, business and purpose of this corporation is non-political, and shall be devoted to promoting scriptural, practical and personal holiness and holy living; to conduct and maintain, acquire and hold such real and personal property as may be necessary, convenient, and advantageous for the conduct and maintenance of religious worship and the conduct and maintenance of schools and other plants for the furtherance of education, and to mortgage and dispose of the same in any manner conducive to the interests of the corporation and the purposes for which it is formed; to assist in charitable work of any nature deemed beneficial and to the best interests of the corporation and to society; and

to raise funds for carrying the same into effect in any manner allowed by the Constitution and Bylaws of the corporation and permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho and the Constitution of the United States of America.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.
