ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE PEOPLES CHURCH OF COEUR D'ALENE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

that we, the undersigned, all citizens and residents of the United States of America and of the State of Idaho, of legal age, acting as incorporators of a non-profit religious corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho, do adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be

THE PEOPLES CHURCH OF COEUR D'ALENE, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The object, business and purpose of this corporation is nonpolitical, and shall be devoted to promoting scriptural, practical and
personal holiness and holy living; to conduct and maintain, acquire and
hold such real and personal property as may be necessary, convenient,
and advantageous for the conduct and maintenance of religious worship
and the conduct and maintenance of schools and other plants for the furtherance of education, and to mortgage and dispose of the same in any
manner conducive to the interests of the corporation and the purposes
for which it is formed; to assist in charitable work of any nature deemed
beneficial and to the best interests of the corporation and to society; and

to raise funds for carrying the same into effect in any manner allowed by the Constitution and Bylaws of the corporation and permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho and the Constitution of the United States of America.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post office address of this corporation shall be: Route 4, Box 19, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI.

This corporation is not organized for profit and has no authority to issue capital stock.

ARTICLE VII.

The government and business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a board of three (3) directors, to be elected by the members for terms fixed in the Bylaws of this corporation. The directors who shall act for one year and until their successors are elected are as follows:

Ben Kelterborn, Route 2, Hayden Lake, Idaho.

Such directors were elected in conformity with the provisions contained in Idaho Code, Section 30-1101, which election was held at the Seventh Day Adventist Church, Ill Locust Avenue, City of Coeur d'Alene, County of Kootenai, State of Idaho, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. on December 1, 1971, at which time and place a majority of the members of the association who were present at such meeting voted at the election which resulted in the election of such directors. Notice of the time and place of holding such election was given by publication in the Coeur d'Alene Press, a daily newspaper, published in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, on the 17th and 24th days of November, 1971, and by posting said notice in a conspicuous place at said church or meeting house, Ill Locust Avenue, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, where said election was held, for a period of two consecutive weeks.
