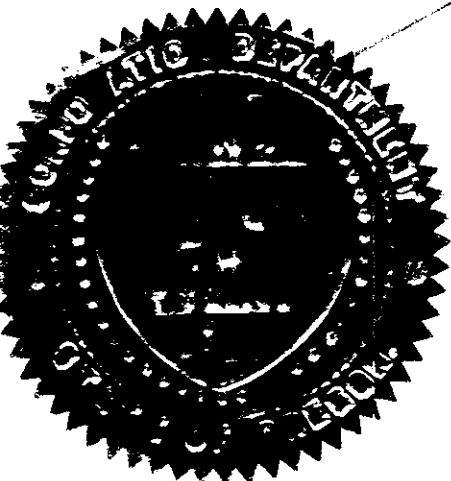

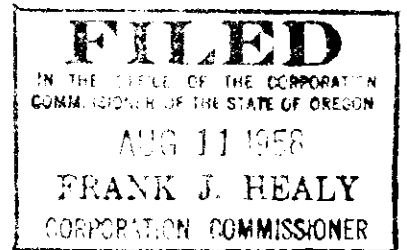

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONSTRUCTION FABRICATORS, INC.

FILE NO. 66452



We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is

CONSTRUCTION FABRICATORS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The period of existence of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To fabricate and erect timber structures and trusses.
2. To buy, own, lease, pledge, mortgage, manufacture or otherwise acquire and deal in personal property of all kinds, and to own, hold, use, improve, operate, lease, sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate or otherwise dispose of the same.
3. To buy, own, lease, demise, mortgage or otherwise acquire, for purpose of investment or otherwise, real property of all kinds, and to use, improve, operate, lease, mortgage, sell, convey, deal in and otherwise dispose of the same.

4. To conduct and transact the business of builders and contractors in all of its phases, and to do building, structural, construction, erection, surveying, dredging, shoring, wrecking, salvage, mechanical and electrical work of every kind in every part of the world, to perform engineering, designing and architectural work, including the preparation of plans and specifications, and to engage in supervising, designing, constructing, managing and operating any and all work.

5. To acquire, receive, hold, sell and dispose of goods, wares, accessories, auxiliaries, merchandise, machines, supplies, equipment and all manner of personal property upon consignment or upon commission, either as principal, agent, manufacturer's agent, broker or factor, and to act as representative, agent, distributor, broker or factor for other persons, firms or corporations.

6. To borrow money on notes, mortgages, bonds or otherwise for general purposes or any special purposes of the corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and convey in trust all or any of its property to secure the payment of any such indebtedness.

7. To guarantee any indebtedness of any individual, partnership or corporation and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and convey in trust all or any of the property of this corporation to secure the payment of any such indebtedness and guarantee.

8. To acquire, own, hold, sell or otherwise dispose

of patents, patent rights, copyrights, trade-marks, trade names and any and all similar rights, privileges, grants or franchises.

ARTICLE FOUR

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is five hundred (500) shares of the par value of Ten Dollars (\$10), each.

ARTICLE FIVE

The address of its initial registered office in the State of Oregon is 800 Pacific Building, Portland 4, Oregon, and the name of its initial registered agent is Frank H. Spears.

ARTICLE SIX

The number of directors of the corporation may be fixed by the bylaws, but shall not be less than three (3).

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors is three (3), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and qualified are:
