That Zion's Co-Operative Mercantile and Manufacturing
Institution of Oakley was a corporation existing on the of day of July,
one thousand eight hundred ninety, formed under the laws of the State (then
Territory) of Idaho, and is now at the date hereof still existing.

That a meeting of the directors of said corporation, duly called, was held on the eighteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, at twelve o'clock noon, at the place of business of said corporation in the Village of Oakley, County of Cassia, State of Idaho.

That, at said time and place, all the directors assembled as the board of directors of said corporation, and that the undersigned acted as Chairman and Secretary of the said meeting.
