ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF T. & T. FARMING COMPANY,
A CORPORATION.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME:

That we, whose names are hereunto subscribed, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, and each of us being of full legal age, do under and pursuant to the General Corporation Laws of the State of Idaho, associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a body corporate, and do now declare these as the Articles of Incorporation of T. & T. FARMING COMPANY, a Corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be:

T. & T. FARMING COMPANY, a Corporation.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- a. To purchase, own, lease, acquire, cultivate, and develop farms and farm lands, stock farms and grazing lands, and all other kinds of real property, and all rights, interests, and easements therein.
- b. To buy, sell, and handle farm products and kindred products of every nature and description.
- c. To raise, buy, sell and feed livestock.
- d. To deal in properties of every kind and nature on its own account or for commission, and to construct properties for all purposes.
- e. To conduct and carry on business of any and all kinds, and to deal in property of every nature and kind, and to do any and all things necessary to enhance the value of the corporation's properties or rights.
- f. To do any and all things necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or for the attainment of any of the objects or for the exercise of any of the powers herein set forth whether specified or not, either alone or in connection with other firms, individuals or corporations, and to do any other act, or acts, thing or things incidental or pertinent to or connected with the business hereinbefore described, or any part or parts thereof, and to promote the objects for which said corporation is formed, to borrow money, and to give such security therefor as may be directed by the Board of Directors.


