We, the undersigned residents of Bingham County and State of Idaho, hereby form ourselves into a body corporate to be known as The Snake River National Park and Pacific Railway Company*

The purpose for which this corporation is organized and incorporated is to construct, maintain and operate a standard guage rail road to run from Idaho Falls in Bingham County and State of Idaho to certain coal fields in Uintah County, State of Wyoming on the Grosventre River, about thirty five (35) miles from where said river empties into the Snake River and cometimes called "Snake River Coal Fields"; also with a branch from said Idaho Falls to the South end of Jackson's Lake in Uintah County, Wyoming. Said rail road with its branch to be about one hundred and sixty (160) miles in length, for the carriage of freight and passengers and the general business of like corporations.

THIRD.

The principal place of business of this corporation and where its principal business is to be transacted shall be at Idaho Falls, in Bingham County, Idaho.

The term for which this corporation is to exist is to be fifty (50) years.
