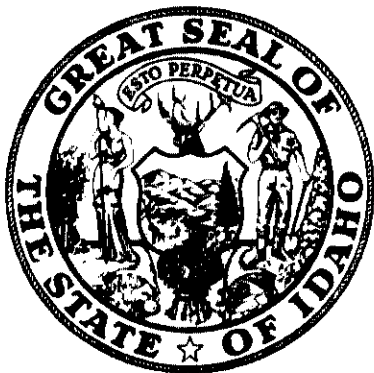

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

GRACE BIBLE CHURCH OF BOISE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is GRACE BIBLE CHURCH OF BOISE, INC.

SECOND: The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

THIRD: The period of its duration is perpetual.

FOURTH: The corporation is organized to operate a church, which shall be exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provisions of any future Federal Tax Code; and to own, operate and maintain on a non-profit basis facilities for its operations; and and to do any and all other acts or things necessary to carry out these purposes as may be allowed under the laws of the State of Idaho and the Internal Revenue Code, and any amendments thereto.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 200 N. 4th St., Suite 300, Boise, Idaho 83702, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Fred Ramey.

SIXTH: Pursuant to Section 30-314(d), Idaho Code, The Board of Directors of the corporation shall be known as the Board of Elders. The number of elders constituting the Board of Elders shall be as set forth in the By-Laws, but shall be not less than three (3), and the initial

Board of Elders who shall hold office until their successors are elected are:

SEVENTH: (a) The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Federal Tax Code.

(b) It is intended by the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation that the corporation shall possess the status of an organization exempt from Federal Income taxation under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as now in force or hereafter amended. Accordingly, no part of the affairs of the corporation shall be administered, directly or indirectly, in any manner whatsoever which might jeopardize the tax exempt status of the corporation.

(c) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers

or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Fourth hereof.

(d) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

(e) Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets of the corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

(f) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.
