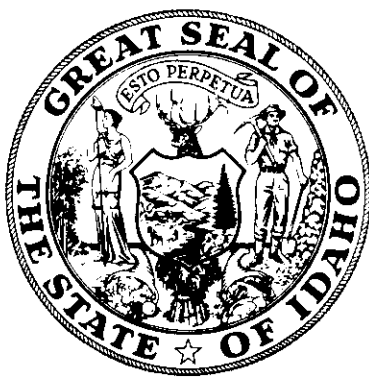

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KIRK, INC.

we, the undersigned, all being of legal age and citizens of the United States, hereby associate ourselves together to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and for such purposes sign the following Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Article I: The name of the corporation shall be KIRK, Inc.

Article II: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho, as the same may be extended from time to time, and specifically but not exclusively, the purpose of selling Fertilizer.

Article III: The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

Article IV: The principal location and address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho shall be as follows:
