

Articles of Incorporation of the Silver City Telegraph Company

Know all men by these presents:

That the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Territory of Idaho: and we hereby certify.

First: That the name of said corporation is the Silver City Telegraph Company.

Second: That the purpose for which it is formed is the construction and maintenance and use of a line of electric telegraph from the town of Silver City to the town of Caldwell, Idaho, and to other points in said Territory.

Third: That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the town of Silver City, in the County of Quay.

Fourth: That the term for which it is to exist shall be fifty years from the date of its incorporation.

Fifth: That the number of its directors shall be five and that the names of those who are appointed for the first year are -

Sixth: That the amount of the Capital stock of this corporation shall be ten thousand (\$10,000) dollars, divided into ten thousand (10,000) shares of one (\$1) dollar each.
