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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned.

Field (each of whom is a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of the State of Washington) have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and in pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate originals, and state as follows:

Section 5. To erect, construct, maintain improve, rebuild, enlarge, alter, manage and control, directly or through ownership of stock in any corporation or otherwise, any and all kinds of buildings, houses, stores, offices, shops, warehouses, factories, mills, machinery, and plants and any and all other structures and erections which may at any time be necessary, useful, or advantageous for the purposes of the corporation.

Section 6. To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise to dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with goods, wares and merchandise and real and personal property generally of every class and description.

Section 7. To purchase or otherwise acquire, so far as permitted by law, the whole or any part of the undertaking and business of any person, firm or corporation engaged in a 1 isiness of the same general character as that for which this corporation is organized, and the property and liabilities, including the good will, assets, and stock in trade thereof, and to pay for the same either in cash or shares of stock, or partly in cash and partly in shares of stock.

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Section 10. To borrow money, and to make and issue notes, bonds debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by morigage, pledge or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.

Section II. To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers herein before set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things incidential or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects or purposes or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsist and with the laws under which this corporation is organized.
