AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Reubens in the County of Levis , and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

0F

REUBENS COMMUNITY CLUB, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Religious, Social, and Benevolent Corporations Act, Title 30, Chapter 11, Idaho Code, dochereby certify as follows:

I.

The name of this corporation is:

THE REUBENS COMMUNITY CLUB, INC.

II.

The purposes and objects for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

- a. To assist in the maintenance of the local Community Church.
- b. To develop an increased civic interest.
- c. To develop and promote social fellowship and companionship among its members.
- d. And for the accomplishment of all social, benevolent, and charitable purposes that may be a benefit to the corporation and the Reubens community area in general.

The corporation shall have and exercise in the accomplishment of such purposes the following particular powers and authority:

a. To acquire by grant, gift, purchase, lease, devise or bequest, and to hold unlimitedly, such real and personal property of every kind and description within or without the State of Idaho which is suitable, necessary, useful er advisable in connection with any or all of the objects hereinbefore or herein-

after set forth; and to convey, sell, assign, transfer, lease, mortgage, pledge, exchange or otherwise dispose of such property, subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by law.

- b. To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sert and kind with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, body pelitic, regovernment or state; and without limit as to amount, to draw, make, accept, enderse, execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, and other negotiable instruments and evidences, whether secured by mortgage or otherwise, as well as to secure the same by mortgage or otherwise, so far as may be permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho.
- c. To build, erect, construct, purchase, hire or otherwise acquire, own, provide, establish, maintain, hold, lease and operate offices, buildings, structures, works, and all other things of whatsoever kind and nature within or without the State of Idaho suitable, necessary, useful or advisable in connection with the conducting of a social, benevolent, and charitable corporation.
- d. To exercise generally the powers customarily exercised by social, benevolent and charitable associations, and particularly the powers provided by the
 laws of the State of Idaho.
- e. To do each and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the abjects herein enumerated, or which shall at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of this corporation.

The foregoing clauses, by reason of the specific enumeration of powers, shall not be held to restrict the power of the corporation to do any of the things within the purview of its general purposes.

III.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in this state, and the principal place of business, shall be at Reubens,
Lewis County, State of Idaho.

The corporation shall be monstock, and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof.

Those becoming members of the Reubens Community Club shall thereby be entitled to membership in the corporation.
