ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

H & H GLASS CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, each of whom is a resident of the United States of America, of legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and pursuant thereto, we hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be H & H GLASS CO., INC.
ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

- (a) To conduct and carry on the business of acquiring, selling and installing glass, of any kind or nature, in any kind of vehicle, building, structure, or in any other item or place.
- (b) To conduct and carry on a retail gasoline business either of a self-service type, a coin operated type, or with an attendant present, and to acquire, sell and trade in any and all items consistent with operation of a gasoline business including, but not limited to, tires, batteries, auto parts and accessories, food, beverages, sporting goods, and any other items deemed desirable. Latter items may be sold even though no gasoline business is conducted.
- (c) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage and, or, lease, real and personal property, to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage, and, or, convey any rights, privileges, franchises on or to real or personal property.
- (d) In the purchase or acquisition of property, business, rights or franchises, or for additional working capital, or for any other object in or about its business or affairs, and without

limit as to amount, to incur debts, and to raise, borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, warrants, debentures, obligations, negotiable or transferable instruments and evidence of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge, Deed of Trust, or otherwise.

- (e) To sue and be sued, appear and complain and defend in any Court of law and equity or before any Board, Commission or Tribunal.
- To employ persons and to appoint such officers, employees and agents as the business of the corporation may require and to allow such employees, officers and, or, agents compensation, and from time to time to provide and carry out and recall, abolish, revise, amend, alter or change, a plan or plans for the participation by all or any of the employees, including directors and officers of the corporation or of any corporation in which or in the welfare of which the corporation has any interest, and those actively engaged in the conduct of the corporation's business, in the profits of the corporation's legitimate expense, and for the furnishing to said employees and persons or any of them, at the corporation's expense, of medical services, insurance against accident, sickness or death, pensions during old age, disability or unemployment, education, housing, social services, recreation or other similar aids for their relief or general welfare, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Board of Directors.
- or property of any corporation engaged in a business similar to that authorized to be conducted by this corporation, and to undertake in conjunction therewith any liability of any person, firm, association or corporation described as aforesaid, possession of property suitable for any of the purposes of this corporation, or for carrying on any business which this corporation is authorized

to conduct.

- (h) To enter into partnership or into any arrangement for sharing of profits, union of interests, co-operation, joint adventure, reciprocal concession or otherwise, with any person or company carrying on or engaged in or about to carry on or engage in any business or transaction which the company is authorized to carry on or engage in, or any business or transaction capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company, and to lend money to, guarantee the contracts of, or otherwise assist any such person or company, and to take or otherwise acquire shares and securities of any such company, and to sell, hold, reissue, with or without guaranty, or otherwise deal with the same.
- (i) To do all things necessary, essential, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any and all of the afore-mentioned purposes or the attainment of any and all of the objects above mentioned or incident to the powers herein named, or which shall at any time appear to be conducive or expedient or beneficial to this corporation, and to such end to have any and all powers conferred upon corporations organized under the general laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The registered office of this corporation and the principal place for the transaction of its business is hereby designated as Box 77, Old Yellowstone Highway South, Rigby, Jefferson County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V

The amount of the total authorized capital stock of this corporation is Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), divided into seventy-five thousand (75,000) shares of common capital stock with equal voting rights of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) each.

Such stock is and shall remain non-assessable.

ARTICLE VI

The private property of the stockholders of this corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporation debts to any extent whatsoever.

ARTICLE VII

The Directors, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote, may repeal, amend, and, or, adopt new By-Laws, which By-Laws may be further repealed, amended, and, or, adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the outstanding shares. By-Laws amended, repealed, and, or, adopted by two-thirds (2/3) of the outstanding shares, cannot thereafter repealed, amended and, or, adopted by the Directors.

ARTICLE VIII
