ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

HARVARD LADIES AID SOCIETY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age, bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, and two-thirds of whom are citizens of the United States, associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit, social, and benevolent corporation under the provisions of Chapter II, Title 30, Idaho Code, amendatory and supplemental thereto, and we do certify and declare as follows:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of the corporation shall be "HARVARD LADIES AID SOCIETY, INC."

ARTICLE II.

That the objects and purpose for and which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To receive gifts and grants of money and property of every kind and to administer the same for charitable, educational, civic, and philanthropic uses and to do anything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of these purposes.

To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage, and/or lease, real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guaranty, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, domestic or foreign;

To appoint such officers, employees and agents as the business of the corporation may require and to allow them compensation;

To enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind essential, necessary or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs,
