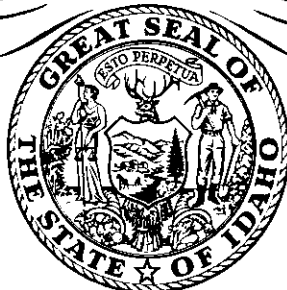

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that

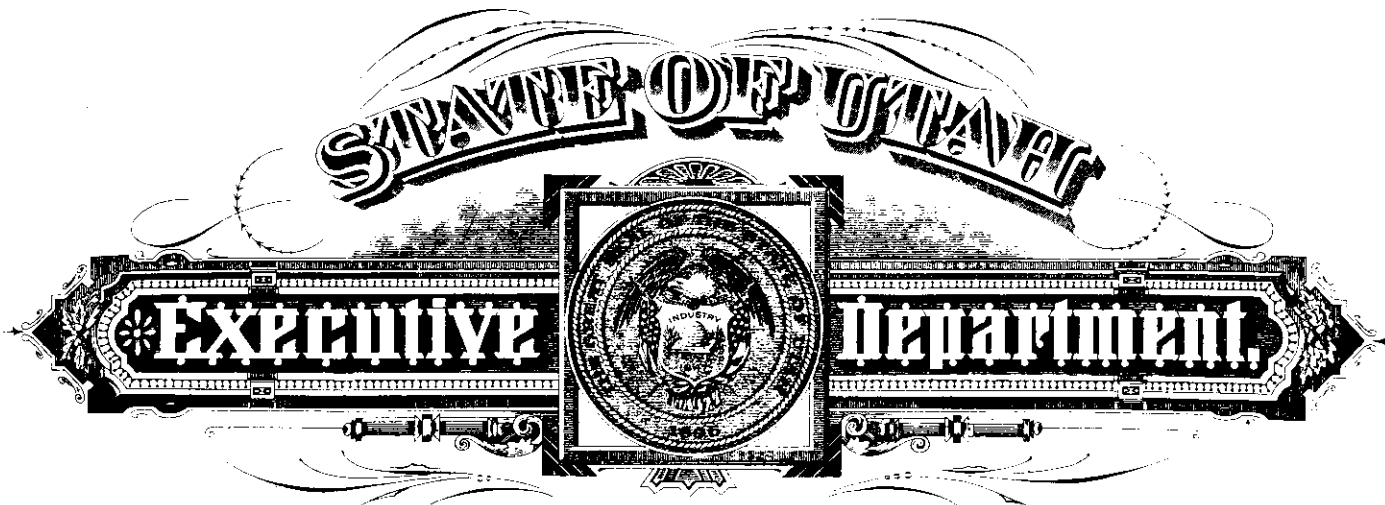
#### CHURCH OF RELIGIOUS SCIENCE OF UTAH

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

CHURCH OF RELIGIOUS SCIENCE OF UTAH

a corporation sole

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Pursuant to Title 16, Chapter 7, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended,  
I do hereby certify and declare:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be CHURCH OF RELIGIOUS SCIENCE  
OF UTAH.

ARTICLE II

The purposes and object of this corporation are as follows:

- (a) To maintain and operate a Church of Religious Science.
- (b) To engage in religious, education, social, charitable and recreational activities, and to provide, furnish and make available education, information, advice and training in relation to religious and mental science, philosophy, psychology, religion, metaphysics and related subjects; to maintain churches, conduct religious services, and perform any and all religious functions, and render such services, and to do any and all such other lawful acts and things as may be deemed necessary, expedient, or appropriate for the accomplishment or furtherance of, or in connection with, these purposes.
- (c) To purchase, acquire, hold, lease, sell, hypothecate or otherwise deal with property, real and personal, of every kind and description; to borrow and loan money; to issue bonds, execute mortgages, and/or deeds of trust, to accept annuities, gifts, legacies, devises and/or bequests; to acquire by purchase, subscription, or otherwise, and hold, use, vote, sell, assign or hypothecate shares of the capital stock of other corporation, whether incorporated under the laws of this state or any other state or nation; to publish, sell and distribute books, circulars, papers, and/or magazines or other literature, and to do everything suitable, proper and convenient for the accomplishment of the foregoing.

ARTICLE III

At the time of making of these Articles of Incorporation this corporation has no property of any nature whatsoever.

ARTICLE IV

The undersigned, Reverend Ray H. Sherwood, is the minister of the Church of Religious Science of Utah.

ARTICLE V

This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, nor the distribution of dividends or property to the members thereof.

ARTICLE VI

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in Salt Lake County, State of Utah.
