THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of organizing a corporation under the General Business Corporations Law of the State of Idaho, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

I.

NAME

The name of the Corporation is K & R FARMS, INC.

II.

DURATION

The existence of this Corporation is to be perpetual after its incorporation, unless sooner dissolved or dis-incorporated pursuant to law.

III.

PURPOSE

1. To acquire farm properties and other real estate, by purchase, lease or otherwise, to improve and develop the same, and thereon to plant, sow, cultivate and harvest potatoes, grains, hay, forage, vegetables, fruit, flowers and all kinds of farm produce and commodities and products of the soil. To breed, raise, buy, pasture, prepare for market, exhibit, sell and deal in livestock of all kinds. To engage in dairying and the poultry, pigeon, pet stock and market gardening business. To operate greenhouses, hot beds and cold frames for the raising of plants, shrubs and flowers. To acquire and maintain shops, stores, stalls, market stands, peddling and delivering vehicles, routes and all other conveniences and equipment suitable for the vending of its products. In general, to conduct and alter several departments and branches, the business of farmers, fruit growers, dairymen, stock raisers, gardeners, nurserymen, and florists, and to do everything incidental or conducive to the full accomplishment of the foregoing objects.

2. To own, operate and maintain and to construct, acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise truck lines and any other means of transportation now or hereafter in use for the transportation of freight, goods, wares, merchandise, farm commodities of every kind and nature, and to conduct, engage in and carry on the business of transportation of property of every class and description and of persons and by any means of transportation now or hereafter in use; and to own, operate, maintain, hold and use, purchase, construct, establish, lease or otherwise acquire, mortgage, create security interest in, and sell or otherwise dispose of or deal with terminal properties and depose, storage facilities, machine and repair shops, grain and other elevators, rolling stock, motors, buses, trucks, automobiles and all structures, tools, machinery, appliances and appurtenances and any and all property, real, personal or mixed, wheresoever situated, whether or not similar to any property above-described, which may be necessary useful in connection with the business of the corporation.

3. To purchase, receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways acquire import, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise, use, enjoy, exercise, operate, in respect of, trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, encumber, transfer, assign and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike any of the foregoing) deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal, or mixed, tangible or intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to, money, credits, chooses in action, securitites, stocks, bonds, warrants, script, certificates, debentures, mortagages, notes, commercial paper, and other obligations in evidence of interest in or domestic, or of any government or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of titles, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property, real property (improved or unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance thereto, including, but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas, and water rights, all or any part of any going buusiness and its incidents, franchises, subsidies, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any government or subdivision or agency thereof, and any interst in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunitiess of individfuals owners or holders thereof.

4. To hire and employ agents, servants and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment and collective bargaining agreements, and to act as agent, contractor, trustee, factor, or otherwise, either alone or in company with others.

5. To promote or aid in any manner, financial or otherwise, any person, firm, association, or corporation, and to guarantee contracts and other obligations.

6. To let concessions to others. To do any of the things that this corporation is empowered to do, and to enter into, make, perform, and carry out, contracts and arrangements of every kind and character with any person, firm, association, or corporation, or any government or authority or subdivision or agency thereof.

7. To carry on any business whatsoever that this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or that it may deem calculated, directly or indirectly, to improve the interest of this corporation, and to do all things specified under the General Business Corporations Law of the State of Idaho, other than the banking business, the trust company business, or the practice of a profession permitted to be incorporated by the General Business Corporations Law of the State of Idaho, as such law as now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended, and to do any and all things hereinabove set forth to the same extent and as full as natural persons might or could do, either alone or in connection with other persons, firms, associations, or corporations, and in any part of the world.

The foregoing statement or purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, shall be liberally construed in aid of the powers of this corporation, and the powers and purposes stated in each clause, shall, except where otherwise stated, be in nowise limited or restricted by any term or provision of any other clause, and shall be regarded not only as independent purposes, but the purposes and powers stated shall be construed distributively as each object expressed, and the enumeration as to specific powers shall not be construed as to limit in any manner the aforesaid general powers, but are in furtherance of, and in addition to, and not in limitation of said general powers.

#### IV.

##### AUTHORIZED SHARES

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 10,000 common shares with a \$1.00 par value per share. Such shares shall be of a single class.

No preferences, qualifications, limitations, restrictions, or special rights, other than those provided by law, shall exist with respect to any of the shares of the corporation or any of the holders of such shares.

V.

VI.

REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The registered office for K & R Farms, Inc., is to be located at 273 S. 1300 W., Pingree, Idaho. The registered agent in charge thereof is Rick Shawver.

VII.

DIRECTORS

The powers of the incorporator are determinate upon the obtaining of a certificate of incorporation, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of stockholders or until their successors are elected and qualified are as follows:

VIII.

RIGHT TO AMEND

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provisions contained within these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter

prescribed by the General Business Corporations Law of the State of Idaho and all rights conferred upon stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

IX.

PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS DENIES

No holder of any of the shares now or hereafter issued by the corporation shall be entitled as a matter of right to subscribe for or purchase any part of the unissued shares of the corporation of any class that may be currently in existence or come into existence in the future or to describe for or purchase any additional shares, whether common, preferred, or of any other class, to be issued by reason of any increase in the authorized capital of the corporation, or to subscribe for or purchase any bonds, certificates of indebtedness, debentures, or other securities, convertible into shares of the corporation. Any and all such unissued shares and such additional authorized issue of new shares and such securities convertible into shares may be issued, allotted, and disposed of to such persons, firm, corporations, or associations and for lawful consideration upon such terms as the Board of Directors may deem advisable and for the best interests of the corporation.

X.

LOCATION

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted and the registered office of the corporation in this state shall be 273 S. 1300 W., Pingree, Bingham County, Idaho.

XI.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

That the management of this Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors of not less than one or no more than five directors as may be fixed by the Bylaws. Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the stockholders, to be held at the general office of the corporation in said Pingree, Idaho, at a time in each year, to be designated by the Bylaws.

BYLAWS


The Bylaws of this corporation may be adopted by the shareholders in the manner provided for by the General Business Corporations Law of the State of Idaho.
